The Little Book of Design for Health in Latin America

A team of international researchers from Latin America and the UK are collating case studies of projects related to the application of design for health and healthcare in Latin American countries.

We invite you to submit a **500 words case study** of your project in **Spanish, Portuguese** (Brazilian) or **English** (see the Case Study Submission Format section at the end of this document).

All case studies will be peer-reviewed by the editorial committee and team of reviewers. Accepted case studies will be published in a Little Book format (A5 size ~ 40 pages), both online and print versions. An open/free online format will be in Spanish, Brazilian Portuguese and English. Print format will be in dual language (i.e. front Spanish, back English or front Portuguese, back English).

The Little Book will be jointly published (with ISSN) by ImaginationLancaster at Lancaster University, UK and Universidad del Desarrollo, Chile.

Launch event: Online in June 2022 and during DRS 2022 in Bilbao (pending DRS approval.) All authors to be invited to the online launch.

¹ Little books are 30-50 page A5-size print & PDF guides providing text interfaces between policy, public audiences and guidance for practical implementation by bringing together rigorous academic research and real-world case studies. They are assigned an ISSN number and are indexed and searchable.



Little Book Structure: The Little Book will be divided into three parts. The first part (Part I) will include an introduction into the field of design for health and present the reader with a brief summary of the emerging themes and case studies that will be presented in Part II. Part II will include several case studies from across Latin American countries organised thematically including reflections and comments by the editors who selected them. Part III will provide an analysis of the strengths, gaps and opportunities for design for health research in Latin America.

- **Aim of the project**
- **Stakeholders involved:** names of stakeholders are optional, the most important is to include type, such as: government, education, private health sector, etc.
- **Process**
- **Outcome**
- **Reflections** emphasize the impact of a design-oriented approach, main challenges throughout the process.
